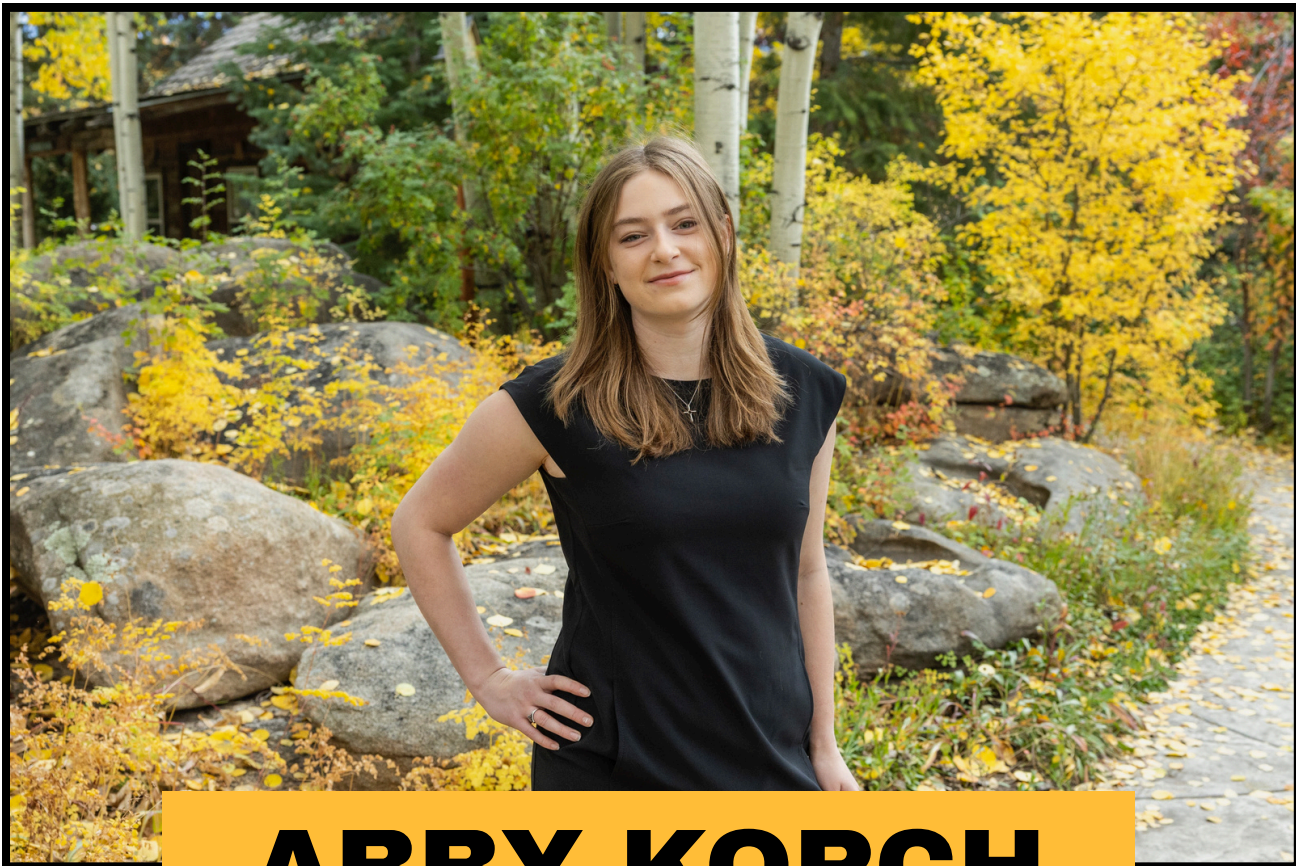

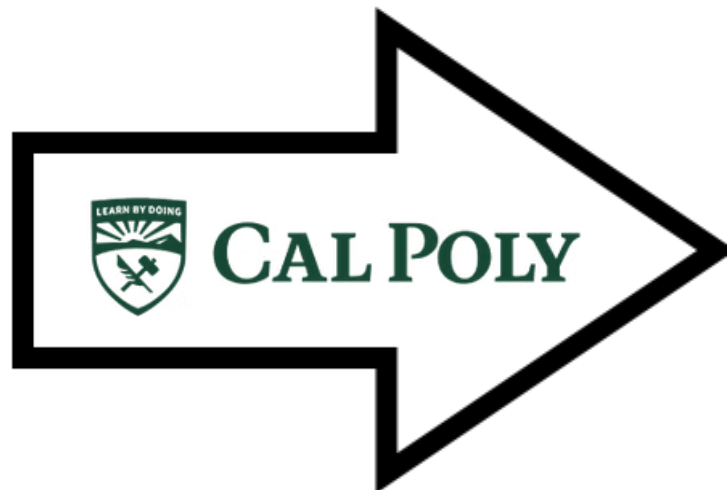
ABBY KORCH
